

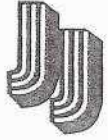

J-k tunnel collapse: 3 more bodies recovered, search on for 6 others

BANIHAL, MAY 21 /--/ Three more bodies were recovered from the debris of an under-construction tunnel on the Jammu-Srinagar national highway that collapsed recently, raising the death toll to four, officials said on Saturday.

The operation to rescue nine labourers feared trapped under the debris resumed early on Saturday after a fresh landslide on Friday evening had forced the authorities to suspend the process. After a hectic

search stretching several hours, the rescue teams recovered two bodies and they were shifted to a nearby hospital for identification, the officials said. Another body was spotted under the debris and efforts are underway to pull it out, they added. The audit tunnel of T3 on the highway near Khooni Nallah in Jammu and Kashmir's Ramban district caved in at the start of the work at around 10.15 pm on Thursday, after which officials had

confirmed that a labourer had died and three others were rescued. Nine were feared trapped under the debris. An operation to rescue them was soon launched but had to be suspended on Friday evening due to a fresh landslide and inclement weather. Over 15 rescuers, including the Station House Officer of Ramsu police station, Nayeem-Ul-Haq, had a narrow escape during this time, according to the officials. (PTI)

Chennai-based man among two held for smuggling drugs using morphed Aadhaar cards

BENGALURU, MAY 21 /--/ Two people, including a Chennai-based drug smuggler, who allegedly used morphed Aadhaar cards to smuggle contraband have been arrested by Customs officials.

The authorities warned public not to share their personal documents to unscrupulous elements which may be misused. According to a statement issued by the Customs officials on Saturday, the officers of Customs Intelligence Unit (CIU) and Special Intelligence and Investigation Branch (SIIB), Bengaluru Airport and Air Cargo Commissionerate, received an intelligence input on April 29. Based on it, they intercepted a consignment at the International Courier Terminal in Bengaluru that was to be exported to

of the consignment revealed pouches of a white crystalline substance concealed within readymade garments. Upon testing, officials found that it was ephedrine, weighing 4.496 kg, and having a market price of about Rs 89.92 lakh. The drug was seized under the provisions of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act, the statement said. The exporter was arrested and produced before a special NDPS court, which remanded him to judicial custody. Investigation also led to the Chennai-based smuggler, who used to book such shipments for exports, using morphed Aadhaar cards to avoid getting caught. In the follow-up action, officers of Andhra Pradesh Police arrested the Chennai-based person who had morphed the Aadhaar card

Guntur with his own photograph and had approached a courier agency in Vijayawada to export the above mentioned shipment. He was remanded to judicial custody for various offences under the Indian Penal Code, the Customs officials said. "It was observed that certain unscrupulous

Tourism boom in J-K due to scorching heat, not any better situation here: Azad

JAMMU, MAY 21 /--/ Veteran Congress leader Ghulam Nabi Azad on Saturday said the current tourism boom in Jammu and Kashmir is due to the rising temperature in the rest of the country and not because of any improved situation in the Union territory.

Azad made the assertion, reiterating his stand on the Delimitation Commission report, saying that the tailor-made report is in contradiction with the ground realities. Azad, the J&K former chief minister, called for united efforts to finish militancy and also urged the government to accept the genuine demands of vulnerable sections of the society to ensure that they are not put in harm's way. The government should not be happy over the increase in tourist arrivals (in Kashmir) and link it with the (improved) situation, he said. I give full credit for the tourism boom to the almighty as the rising temperatures in Delhi and the rest of the country prompted people to look for cooler environs in Kashmir, Shimla and elsewhere, Azad told reporters here. Azad reached Jammu on a two-day visit and presided over a function at the party headquarters to pay tributes to former Prime Minister Rajiv Gandhi on

his death anniversary. He is scheduled to return to Srinagar on Sunday. Flanked by senior leaders including J&K Pradesh Congress Committee (JKPCC) president G A Mir and working president Raman Bhalla, Azad said the mercury in Delhi touched 49.9 degrees Celsius and it was hovering between 47 and 48 degrees C in most parts of the country. The people started fleeing to hill stations even ready to spend their time in tents or on roads to beat the heat, he added. There is no role of the state in the increased tourist footfall (in Kashmir), he said.

The veteran Congress leader expressed concern over the growing terror activities in Kashmir and said we all need to join hands to finish militancy (in Jammu and Kashmir). The genuine demands of the vulnerable sections of the society, whether they are Kashmiri pandits, Sikhs or Muslims who are on the hit list (of terrorists) should be accepted.

We should not put them in harm's way, he said. Asked about the Delimitation Commission report which took effect in Jammu and Kashmir with the issuance of a notification by the Union law ministry on Friday, Azad said he and other Congress leaders have made it clear that they are not satisfied with the report which

contradicts the ground realities. It is a tailor-made report and prepared in such a way to benefit some and cause loss to whom they intend to, the Congress leader said.

The panel's two orders -- one of March 14 dealing with the number of constituencies reserved for various categories and the second one of May 5 dealing with the size of each constituency -- came into effect together from May 20. The Commission's report will form the basis for future assembly polls in the Union territory. The delimitation panel had given six additional assembly seats to the Jammu region and one to Kashmir Valley and brought under the Anantnag parliamentary seat.

Jammu division will now have 43 assembly seats and Kashmir 47 in the 90-member house. In response to a question on the row over the use of speakers at religious places, Azad said the aim behind the campaign was to weaken the "ideology of tolerance to create a rift in society. In the 1500-year-old history of our country, Hindus and Muslims have lived together and they will remain so till the end of this world. The temple bells, azan' (call for prayer) from mosques and the prayer meetings at churches and gurudwaras is

all about Bharat and if it stops, Bharat is not going to remain the same, he said. He said the beautiful recitation of bhajans' from temples and azans' from mosques in the early hours makes one proud of the pluralistic country. (PTI)
